## Protective effects of Sodium Ascorbate and Mannitol on *Bifidobacterium* Subjected to Freeze Drying

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The choice of the suspending medium for freeze drying is very important to increasing the survival rate of *Bifidobacterium*. The basal suspending medium(BSM) was 12% nonfat skim milk. The protective effects of some additives such as sodium ascorbate, cysteine, mannitol, adonitol, and yeast extract on the viability of *Bifidobacterium* during and after freeze drying were examined. The addition of 2% sodium ascorbate to BSM increased the viability of *Bifidobacterium* 1.5 times after freeze drying and 2 times during storage. 6% mannitol in BSM did not show any effects on the viability of *Bifidobacterium* after freeze drying, but increased the survival rate of *Bifidobacterium* 2 times during storage.
