## A New Species of Genus Araniella C<sub>HAMBERLIN</sub> & I<sub>VIE</sub>, 1942 (Araneae: Araneidae) from Korea

Small spiders of genus *Araniella* was classified by black spots on the dorsal part of abdomen, *A. displicata* classified by three pairs of spots and *A. cucurbitinus* by four pairs of spots in the past. These species, *Araniella* sp. in Korea still have not been distinguished because of many variations of spots on the dorsal part of abdomen and in Europe, America and Japan were reported to different opinions, same or new species. In this paper, authors would like to describe this species, *Araniella hexamaculata* sp. nov having different palpal organ and epigynum structures. As a result, 67 species, 20 genera is classified in Korean Family Araneidae. This specimens are deposited in the Arachnological Institute of Korea.
