A systematic study of the tachyporine genus *Tachinus* Gravenhorst in Korea is presented. Four species are recognized, two of which are reported for the first time in Korea [*Tachinus (Tachinoderus) nigriceps* Sharp and *Tachinus (Tachinus) sharpi* Bernhauer & Schubert]. The differences and illustrations of morphological characters among members of the Korean *Tachinus* species are presented.
