

## Complex Fixed Prosthodontic Patient Treatment

Diagnosis and treatment planning will be reviewed for a patient with a shortened dental arch, unopposed teeth, less than ideal occlusal plane, faulty restorations, and malposed teeth.

The treatment phase will be covered in detail including interdisciplinary care with orthodontics and periodontics. Instrumentation will be reviewed and the fixed prosthodontics treatment phase will be discussed. The fixed prosthodontic treatment phase will include the use of partial coverage and full coverage restorations.
