- 1. Sex/age: M/56
- 2. Chief Complaint (C.C): "discomfort during mastication in upper left molar"
- 3. Past dental history: RCT on #27 two weeks ago in local clinic,

RCT on #26 two years ago in local clinic.

- 4. Present Illness
 - : Per(+), mob(-), cold(-), EPT(-), probe(W.N.L) on #26, 27 With gold crown, incomplete endodontic filling state on #26 With temporary filling state, amalgam filling state on #27
- 5. Impression
 - : pulpless tooth on #26,27 with chronic apical periodontitis with mesial root resorption suspected on #27.
- 6. Tx Plan: Re-RCT on #26,27

III. Conclusion

Many materials used in dental clinic have some extents of toxicity. Therefore dentists should recognize proper indications and methods in using materials and then, can prevent many iatrogenic complications.
