I. Introduction

Patients with indications of major morphologic modifications have very high expectations and developed senses for esthetics. Conoid teeth, diastema, and interdental space after orthodontic treatment is indications for major morphologic modifications. These clinical situations can correct predictably by means of direct resin composite restorations or porcelain laminate veneers.

This is to present direct resin composite restorations or porcelain laminate veneers for major morphologic modifications on anterior teeth.

1. Sex/age: F/28
2. Chief Complaint (C.C): Old restoration fx on #21
3. Past Dental History (PDH): orthodontic tx hx. (10ys ago), Diastema closure on #11, #21 (4ys ago)
4. Present Illness (P.I): Diastema on #11, #21, Old restoration discoloration on #13, #23
5. Tx Plan: Direct resin restorations on #11, #12, #21, #22

III. Conclusion

Satisfactory results can be obtained by using direct resin composite restorations or porcelain laminate veneers for Major morphologic modifications on anterior teeth.
