Closed (Very Minimal Invasive) Reduction and Pins Fixation Treatment for Displaced Intraarticular Calcaneal Fracture (Cases Presentation)

Treatment for displaced intraarticular calcaneal fracture has been very controversial for last half century. Conservative treatments had been popular until two decades ago, thereafter open reduction and internal fixation have been getting standard treatment for better over all outcomes. But still the operative treatments are very challenging for average orthopedic surgeons due to poor 3 D understanding of the calcaneal fx. as well as lack of enough personal experiences involved.

Author experienced and try to show a nice close reduction technic as good as open reduction and internal fixation treatment for several cases of rather stable displaced intraarticular calcaneal fractures with good functional recovery.
