

## Uveodermatologic Syndrome (Vogt-Koyanagi-Harada-like Syndrome) Concurrent with Panniculitis in a Miniature Poodle Dog

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**Signalment:** A 5-year-old, intact female miniature Poodle was presented with a history of bilateral visual impairment, poliosis, depigmentation, and left sided head tilt.

**Results:** Ocular discharge, corneal neovascularization, conjunctival hyperemia, visual impairment, facial poliosis, depigmentation of muzzle, eyelid and perioral regions with diffuse papulonodular lesions in the dorsum were noted on physical examination. A presumptive diagnosis of uveodermatologic syndrome was made.

Uveodermatologic syndrome was confirmed from histopathologic examination of the muzzle, perioral lesion and ocular tissue. Skin biopsy of dorsal lesion revealed panniculitis.

**Clinical Relevance:** This report shows the first case of uveodermatologic syndrome in a miniature Poodle dog. Concurrent panniculitis was also developed. Uveodermatologic syndrome should be included in differential diagnosis of panniculitis.
